



### **Different ways our degree students have to prove their proficiency in English:**

- TOEFL test results with minimum score of 580 in paper-based test or 92 in iBT (University Admissions Finland's TOEFL institution code is 3138)
- IELTS test results (academic band) with minimum overall band score of 6.5 (each section minimum 5.5)
- PTE Academic (Pearson Test of English, Academic band) results with minimum overall score of 62
- National Certificate of English Language Proficiency (arranged by Finnish National Board of Education before 2012) with minimum overall language proficiency level 5
- CPE test (Certificate of Proficiency in English) with pass grade A, B or C – ID number and secret code need to be provided on the copy of the certificate
- CAE test (Certificate in Advanced English) with pass grade A, B or C – ID number and secret code need to be provided on the copy of the certificate
- Certificate of secondary education completed in English language in an EU / EEA country, United States, Canada, Australia or New Zealand
- Certificate of English as the A1 language as part of an International Baccalaureate examination (minimum grade 2)
- Certificate of English as the A2 language as part of an International Baccalaureate examination (minimum grade 5)
- Certificate of English as the A language (literature/language and literature/language and performance) as part of an International Baccalaureate examination (minimum grade 2)
- Certificate of English as the A language with a minimum grade of Magna Cum Laude Approbatur as part of a Finnish Matriculation examination
- Certificate of English as the LI language as a part of European Baccalaureate examination (minimum grade 4)
- Certificate of English as the LII language as a part of a European Baccalaureate examination (minimum grade 7)
- Bachelor's or Master's degree conducted in English language in an EU / EEA country, United States, Canada, Australia or New Zealand
- Doctoral degree conducted in English language in an EU/EEA country, United States, Canada, Australia or New Zealand
- Bachelor's or Master's degree with English (language/literature/philology) as the major subject
- English language studies included in a Bachelor's or Master's degree conducted in Finland
- Studies as exchange student at the University of Vaasa
